

Confessions of Faith

HOW TO USE:

- Speak these Truths aloud everyday. The more you hear yourself say them aloud, the more you will come into agreement and believe, thus activating your faith to receive (Rom. 10:17).

- Stand on the Word, remain in faith, and let yourself transform (Rom. 12:2) until you see the fruit (Gal. 6:9).
